learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 341, 323, 385, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian

Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the petition with regard to

petitioner No. 1.

Permission is accorded.



Accordingly, the petition with respect to petitioner No. 1 is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is alleged that all the F.I.R named accused persons including the petitioners came at the Chimni of the informant and assaulted him and his brothers, as a result of which, they received injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No. 1 and the informant are business partner and due to some business dispute, this false case has been registered against the petitioners. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. The accusation of making assault with Dab is against petitioner No. 1 whose application has been withdrawn. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, except petitioner No. 1, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be



released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Siwan in connection with G.B. Nagar P.S. Case No. 22 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
