ORAL ORDER

3 10-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Let the defect (s), as pointed out by the office, be removed within a period of four weeks from the date of resumption of physical filing and physical removal of defect.

In the present case, the petitioner seeks bail in connection with Maranchi (Pachmahla O.P.) P.S. Case No. 45 of 2021 registered for the alleged offences under Sections 509, 448, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per prosecution case, the petitioner made an attempt to rape the informant while she was alone. She was somehow saved and when the informant tried to lodge a case, the petitioner and other co-accused persons abused and



threatened the informant and her family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case on dispute over some money transactions. There has been long delay in lodging the F.I.R. and it shows after thought and deliberation on part of the informant. The matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition has been filed before the learned trial court. Charge sheet has been submitted in this case and the petitioner is in custody since 30.07.2021. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner submitting that the victim lady has supported her allegation in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. as well as under Section 161 Cr.P.C.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances and submission made on behalf of the parties and considering the period of custody of the petitioner along with his clean antecedent and submission of charge sheet against him, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Barh, in connection with Maranchi



(Pachamahla O.P.) P.S. Case No. 45 of 2021, subject to the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and also the following conditions:

- (i) One of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner.
- (ii) The petitioner will remain present on each and every date fixed by the court below.
- (iii) In case of absence on three consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, the bail bond of the petitioner will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
