2 02-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366 and 34
of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has antecedent of one case in which petitioner has
been acquitted by the learned trial court and the informant
alleges that his married daughter was kidnapped on 29.07.2021
by seven accused persons, including the petitioner, with a
motive to solemnized marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and the



victim has come back and her statement was recorded under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. in which she has not named the petitioner as has been specifically pleaded at Para-7 of the anticipatory bail application.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No. 200 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
