Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“(i) Issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the Respondents especially Respondent No. 4 & 5 to take final decision on the representation (Annexure-2 to 4 series) and cancel the settlement of New Hari Vatika Bus Stand Canteen and further to refund the amount deposited by the petitioner as neither the work order was provided and moreover due to Pandemic of COVID-19 it was not possible

to run the canteen.”
