2 10-11-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 32(1), 32(3),
41(1) and 41(2) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of
recovery of 887.760 liters of liquor from a place below the cow
shed of Arjun Rai.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that
even the alleged recovery is from a place which does not belong to
the petitioner and he came to be implicated by the villagers but



then the FIR does not disclose the name of the villagers who disclosed his name.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Government Official Comp. P.S. Case No. 135 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
