2 24-02-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“i) For an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders,
direction/directions or commands to the
Respondents not to making ditches and not to
installing or fixing the electric power poles over
the residential land of petitioner under Khata
No. 42, Plot No. 52 measuring an area of 3.08
decimals situated at village – Masipura, I.A.S.



Colony,k near Power grid Colony, P.S. Bodh Gaya, District – Gaya.

ii) For further issuance of an appropriate writ/order/ direction commanding the Respondents to vacate the said above land of the petitioner and possessed her on the said land.

iii) For further issuance of an appropriate writ/order/ direction and commanding the Respondents concerned to make an award of the said land and give the compensation amounts to the petitioner.

iv) And/or any other order/orders for granting any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner is found entitled to 8in the facts and circumstances of this case.”

After the mater was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.

Prayer allowed.

The petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
