ORAL ORDER

8 17-11-2022 The petitioner's counsel submits that because the order of punishment has the effect of withholding of 25% of the pension, the petitioner has approached this Court directly without availing the remedy of appeal before the Divisional Commissioner.

Such submission, in the opinion of the Court, is not sufficient. Since he has remedy of appeal before the Divisional Commissioner, who, in the opinion of the Court, is in a better position to appreciate the circumstance with reference to the facts and the allegations, including evidence placing reliance, on which the petitioner's counsel proposes to make submissions, writ application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to



avail the remedy of appeal, in accordance with law.
