3 21-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following relief:-

1. That this writ application is being filed by the petitioner, in the nature of certiorari for quashing the entire certificate proceeding vide Certificate Case No. 02/2011-12 initiated by the District Certificate Officer, Katihar after lapse of more than 7-8 Years of the scheme, which is per-se illegal and bad in law.

And for further issuance of an appropriate direction, order or writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside part of the Final Report of justice Uday Sinha Judicial Inquiry Commission, passed as on 6th of June 2018 which was headed by justice Uday Sinha as Chairman of the Inquiry commission. By which final report directed to realize the entire loss of Government food grains from the PDS dealers leaving other Government official from vicarious liability or any responsibility. Although total control of public

distribution system under various scheme for food security in the Indian Rural area is totally controlled by State Government through Deputy Development Commissioner (D.D.C) who is incharge of implementation of the 3GRY (Sampoorna Gramin Rozgar Yojana) scheme in each district of State of Bihar.

On 24.02.2022, we have passed the following order:-

“Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the previous occasion, when the matter was called out, no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent/s is/are present.

In the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.

List on 10th of March, 2022.”

Even today, no one appears on behalf of the petitioner.

As a result, this writ application is dismissed for want of prosecution.
