2 14-02-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



1. That this is an application for direction to the Respondent authorities the Respondent No. 2 to 6 to issue order and direction to see that the Bank or financing companies do not seize the vehicle of petitioner Pvt person through goons on road from the Owner of vehicle without any proper order of court or Debt Recovery Tribunal as held by our own High Court reported in BLJ 2020 Page -96 in the case of Sujay Kumar versus UCO Bank Limited, following the ruling of Supreme Court in the case of Shanti Devi versus ICICI Bank Limited as well as further direction to the Respondent No. 7 the Branch Manager Sri Ram Finance Company Limited at with its office at Zero Mile Pahari Per P.S AgamKuan District Patna, not to seize the vehicle of petitioner through goons by illegal means and using force.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Bench not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law as also, should the need so arise, approach this Court by filing a proper petition.

Liberty, as prayed for, granted.

withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
