Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ and/ or order and/ or direction for quashing the letter vide memo no. 1228 dated



22.09.2022 by which the petitioner has been asked to return the excess payment made by the respondents on account of operation of quarantine centre -2020 during Covid-19 Pandemic in the district of Bhojpur at Ara. The petitioner had provided basic electrical facilities such as generator, tube, fan etc. at different quarantine centers during covid-19 pandemic from 26.04.2020 to 19.07.2020 on the oral instructions of the respondents.

It is not in dispute that petitioner's request dated 25.04.2022 (Page-26) is pending before Respondent No. 5, namely, The Circle Officer, Ara Sadar, Ara, Bhojpur.

Shri Sajid Salim Khan, learned Standing Counsel No. 25, appearing for the respondents, states that the petitioner's request shall positively be considered and disposed of within a period of four weeks from today.

Statement accepted and taken on record.

Petitioner undertakes to make himself available in the office of Respondent No. 5, namely, the Circle Officer, Ara Sadar, Ara, Bhojpur on 14th of November, 2022 at 10:30 A.M. and place on record any other additional material in support of



his claim.

Order assigning reasons shall be communicated to the petitioner.

Liberty reserved to the petitioner to challenge the order, should the need so arise subsequently.

The instant petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
