2 07-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under sections 399 and 402 of the Indian Penal Code and sections 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution case, on information having been received about the accused persons having gathered and planning to give effect to an occurrence, it is stated that a raid was conducted and from the possession of the petitioner a loaded country made pistol and a live cartridge were recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. No incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. He is in custody since 21.2.2021 and chargesheet has been



submitted in the case.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case together with the petitioner having remained in custody for over 1 year and investigation in the case having concluded, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case no. 100 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka.
