3 23-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case no. 659 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 342, 323, 307, 504, 506, 153, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 302 IPC has been further added.

It is a case of assaulting to the informant's father as a result of which he succumbed to the injuries.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Specific allegation of assault is against co-accused Ramprit Mukhiya, who had given iron rod blow on the head of



the deceased and the prosecution story is supported by the postmortem report as deceased has received only injury on temporal parital region, which is mentioned in para-43 of the case diary. So far as petitioner is concerned, general and omnibus allegation is levelled against him.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Sitamarhi P.S. Case no. 659 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Sitamarhi subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
