7 01-09-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“For issuance of an appropriate writ in nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, command/commands, Director/Directions for commanding the respondents to not construct Power Sub-Station on the purchased land of the petitioner and direct respondents to enhance award 4 times more compensation as per the right of fair compensation and transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 and it has also been stated in Section 104 perpetual lease and Bihar Raiyati Land Lease Policy, D.L.A. (Lease) Policy 69/2014-1440(5) 4 times more compensation would be liable as the land of the petitioner is residential.”
