“That this is an application for direction to the Respondents Authorities No.2 to 4 to get release the illegally seized vehicle of petitioner as well as the respondent no- No.5 the Branch Manager Tata Motor Finance Purnia Branch Purnia at Purnia to release the Truck No. BR-10GB-9525 of this petitioner



seized forcefully and illegally by their goons on 16.12.2021 through Respondent-6 alleging that some installments amount was due against the said vehicle, which is in dispute.”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition with better particulars, on the same and subsequent cause of action, if so required and desired.

Permission granted with liberty, as prayed for.
