This is an application for regular bail on behalf of the

petitioner for the offences alleged under section 30(a) of Bihar

Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

As per allegation, the petitioner after unloading 3 bags,

having seen the police party began to flee away but he was

apprehended and 21 liters of foreign liquor was recovered from the

said bags.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner is a person of clean antecedents and he is in custody since



24.10.2021.

Considering the clean antecedents and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Rail (Muzaffarpur) P.S. Case no. 148 of 2021, subject to the following conditions:-

1. The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.

2. At the time of furnishing bail bond, the petitioner shall file an affidavit to the effect that he shall not indulge himself in future in the similar type of offence. If it is found so, the prosecution will have liberty to file an application before the court below for cancellation of the bail of the petitioner and the learned court below will take decision in accordance with law.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time mentioned hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
