ORAL ORDER

2 30-05-2022 The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one
month.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
APP for the State.

This is an application for regular bail on behalf of the
petitioner for the offences alleged under sections 307, 379 of the
Indian Penal Code, section 27 of the Arms Act and section 3/ 4 of
Explosive Substance Act.

As per allegation, at the occasion of immersion of effigy
Godess Swarswati, some persons pelted stones and also exploded
bombs. The petitioner is named accused person. Some persons have
sustained injury.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
petitioner is a person of clean antecedents and he is in custody since



15.09.2021. He has submitted further that on similar footing co-accused Md. Neyaz @ Guddu Baba, Md. Shamsher and Md. Sahab Alam @ Rinku @ Tinku have been granted anticipatory bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 8.7.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. no. 1368 of 2021.

Considering the clean antecedents and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna in connection with Pirbahore P.S. Case no. 63 of 2020, subject to the following conditions:-

1. The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
2. If the petitioner is found involved in future in the similar type of offence, the prosecution will have liberty to file an application before the court below for cancellation of the bail of the petitioner and the learned court below will take decision in accordance with law.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time mentioned hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
