3      17-10-2022      Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“1. That this writ application is directed for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of certiorari/ mandamus commanding the responsible respondents for quashing the lottery of result dated 8.1.2018 for L.P.G. Distributorship of Bharat Petroleum Corporation at Kalu Pakar District-East Champaran under S.C.(W) Category as per advertisement No. 17.6.2017 to the respondent no.6. because without any Demo pertaining to lottery or



without giving an opportunity to see the result of lottery on 8.1.2018 and without recording the result of lottery through Surveillance footage (C.C.T.V. Footage) and without giving the priority to the candidate (petitioner) of Phenara Block as per advertisement illegally respondent no.6 has been directly given Distributorship and further for a direction to the responsible respondents to enquire into the matter of the petitioner in the light of application dated 3.4.2018 (contained in Annexure-4).”

On 10.10.2022, we had passed the following order:

“Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.

List this case on 17<sup>th</sup> of October, 2022.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that post allotment to private party the Unit is operational and functional.”

Even today, despite repeated calls and pass over, none appears for the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed for default.
