APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 385, 387 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of ransom demand and snatching a mobile by the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that ransom demand was not executed by this petitioner and the said mobile was not recovered from the possession of this petitioner.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Danapur, Patna in connection with Paliganj P.S. Case No. 383 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
