ORAL ORDER

2 04-11-2022 The limited prayer of the petitioner in the present case is to direct the Circle Officer, Sangrampur, East Champaran i.e. the respondent no. 6 to conclude the proceedings of the pending Encroachment Case No. 02 of 2014-15.

The learned counsel for the respondent State submits



that in case the proceedings of the aforesaid encroachment case has not been taken to its logical conclusion, the same shall be definitely disposed off by the respondent no. 6 by passing appropriate orders under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, within a stipulated time frame.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to respondent no. 6 to dispose off the aforesaid Encroachment Case No. 02 of 2013-14, by passing the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in accordance with law and after hearing the affected parties, within a period of 12 weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
