ORAL ORDER

3 05-12-2022 Though the present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 17.12.2021, issued by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Biharsharif, constituting a Five Men Committee for vacating the land, appertaining to Khata No. 97, Khesra No. 756, Thana No. 107 of Mauza-Muraura, pursuant to the orders passed in the encroachment proceedings bearing Encroachment Case No. 02 of 2021-22, however, the learned counsel for the Respondent-State has submitted that the final



order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, has been passed on 04.10.2021, which has been handed over to this Court and is taken on record, wherein the petitioner has been held to be an encroacher.

In such view of the matter, nothing survives for consideration in the present writ petition, however, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file appropriate appeal, challenging the aforesaid order dated 04.10.2021.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed as having become infructuous.
