Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence under Section 272, 273, 34 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

60 liters of Nepali Saufi wine has been recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedent and he is in custody since 23.10.2021. Investigation is complete.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioner is allowed.



Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Saharghat P.S. Case No. 136 of 2021.
