2 14-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged against the petitioner that he along with co-accused Ravi Mishra used to give threat to the employees of the P.H.C, Sugauli and demanding money by showing themselves as journalists. It is further alleged that on 08.04.2021 at about 11.30 A.M, when the informant being In-charge, Medical Officer, P.H.C,



Sugauli was engaged in meeting with his subordinate employees, the petitioner along with other accused persons forcibly entered in the office and misbehaved with the informant and other officials and threatened of dire consequences.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is a reporter of Champaran Today News Network Pvt. Ltd and when he disclosed the corruption and mal-practice during COVID-19 pandemic, this false case has been lodged against him. The petitioner has not demanded any money to any employee of the P.H.C. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner is accused in two other cases in which he is on bail.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 181 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
