This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Complaint Case No. 5337 of 2018 for the offence punishable
under Sections 323, 504, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code and
under Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the husband of the complainant and for the same
offence for the same period, another criminal case was also filed
by the complainant in which the petitioner was taken into
custody and granted regular bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this bail
application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/surrender within ten weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Patna, in connection with Complaint Case No. 5337 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
