ORAL ORDER

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(The proceedings of the Court are being conducted by Hon'ble the Chief Justice/ Hon'ble Judges through Video Conferencing from their residential offices/residences. Also, the Advocates and the Staffs joined the proceedings through Video Conferencing from their residences/offices.)

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Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-



- (i) For issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions commanding the respondents concerned to give/restore electricity connection to the petitioner, which was given to the petitioner in the year 2013 for a short period and thereafter it was disconnected on objection of his brother with regard to title of property the said electricity connection was taken away without any enquiry and since then the petitioner is living without electricity being debarred from the basic amenities for dignified life at the instance of the respondents.
- (ii) For issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions commanding the respondents to pay appropriate and adequate compensation to the petitioner for their illegal and inhuman actions due to which the petitioner is forced to live without electricity since year 2013 in serious violation of Article 21 of the Constitution of India.
- (iii) For issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions fixing appropriate liability on the respondents for their illegal, inhuman and insensitive actions due to which the petitioner is still suffering since the year 2018.
- (iv) For any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled under law.



After the matter was heard for some, finding the Bench not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

Permission granted.

The present petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
