- 3 25-07-2022 Though the present writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to protect the life and property of the petitioners as provided under the ***Bihar Maintenance & Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizen Rules, 2012*** as also under the ***Maintenance and Welfare of parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007***, however the respondents have filed a counter affidavit, wherein it has been stated that the respondents are maintaining proper watchfulness and the concerned police station has also been instructed regarding the same, so that no



untoward incident takes place *qua* the petitioners herein.

In such view of the matter, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the writ petition be disposed off, however with a direction to the respondents to ensure protection of life of the petitioners.
