ORAL ORDER

2 02-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 50 litres of illicit country
made liquor from a motorcycle. The petitioner is owner
of the seized motorcycle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner was not apprehended from the
spot. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is only owner



of the vehicle in question and she has given the vehicle to the named accused Bidhi Chand Mahto for some urgent work who has misused the vehicle. The petitioner has no concern with the seized illicit liquor. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) in the District Legal Services Authority, Katihar.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 2, Katihar in connection with Manihari P.S. Case No. 93 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section



438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted
by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit
of Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousands) in District Legal
Services Authority, Katihar.
