2 02-12-2022 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State

through virtual Court proceedings.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period of
four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kaler P.S.
Case No. 65 of 2020 registered for the offence under Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and is in
custody since 06.04.2022.

The allegation against the petitioner is to be engaged in
illegal trading/manufacturing of illicit liquor, where, there was
recovery of 1607.4 litres of illicit IMFL/country made liquor.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submitted that the name of petitioner surfaced on the basis of



disclosure made by apprehended co-accused, namely, Rajesh Kumar, where nothing surfaced during the course of investigation to connect this petitioner with alleged recovery of illicit liquor. It is further submitted that the petitioner found involved in one more criminal case, where he is on bail. While concluding the argument, it has been submitted that investigation of this case is completed, for which charge-sheet has been submitted, as such, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Learned APP, opposes the prayer of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances as mentioned above, as recovery of illicit liquor not appears to be made from conscious physical possession of this petitioner coupled with the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Kaler P.S. Case No. 65 of 2020 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise Court No. 2, Jehanabad/concerned Court, subject to the conditions as mentioned under Section 437(3) of the Cr.P.C.
