5      19-09-2022                      Though the present writ petition was filed for directing the Respondent-State to remove the encroachment made by it over the private land of the petitioner by way of construction of a road, however, the Respondent-State had filed a supplementary counter affidavit on 13.9.2022 wherein it has been stated that the encroachment in question made over the plot of the petitioner has been removed and to that effect, the petitioner has also given a



written acknowledgment.
