13 01-11-2022 It is the specific stand of the State in supplementary affidavit that walk-in interview pursuant to the advertisement dated 28.08.2018 with respect to which the instant writ application has been filed claiming relaxation in age criteria was cancelled due to some irregularities. They have stated in the supplementary counter affidavit that after cancelling the interview no merit list has been published and there is no appointment pursuant to the said advertisement.

In view of the above noted developments subsequent



to filing of the writ application, the same has become infructuous.

There is thus no occasion for this Court to express any opinion on the claim of the petitioner for relaxation of the age. The issue is left open for the petitioner to agitate as and when the occasion arises.

The writ petition is dismissed.
