petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State

through virtual Court proceedings.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Basopatti
P.S. Case No. 168 of 2022 registered for the offence under
Sections 272, 273, 414 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and is in
custody since 25.08.2022.

The allegation against the petitioner is to be engaged
in illegal trading/manufacturing of illicit liquor, where, there
was recovery of 180 litres of illicit IMFL/country made liquor.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not connected in any manner with alleged motorcycle and as such it can be safely gathered that recovery of illicit liquor was not made from conscious physical possession of this petitioner. While concluding the argument, it has been submitted that investigation of this case is completed, for which charge-sheet has been submitted, as such, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Learned APP, opposes the prayer of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances as mentioned above, as petitioner is in custody since 25.08.2022, coupled with the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No. 168 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge Excise Act, Madhubani/concerned Court, subject to the conditions as mentioned under Section 437(3) of the Cr.P.C.
