CERTIORARI for quashing the memo no. 304



dated 7.2.19 issued from the office of respondent no. 1 under section 14 of the SARFEESAI Act 2002 connection with SARFEASI Case No. 11/2009 - 10 whereby and whereunder the respondent no.03 the secured creditor under 2(2) of Act has requested to take action against the petitioner and directed to deposit the loan amount with interest within a week failing which necessary action shall be taken

(ii) To Direct the respondent no.03 to allow the petitioner to deposit time a sum of Rs. 1,94,730-40 within a reasonable period of time taking into the consideration of the petitioner's poor financial condition.

(iii) To any other relief/s to which the petitioner may be found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
