2 09-12-2022 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State

through virtual Court proceedings.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period of

four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Sursand P.S.

Case No. 371 of 2022 registered for the offence under Sections 30(a)

of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and is in

custody since 21.07.2022.

The allegation against the petitioner is to be engaged in

illegal trading/manufacturing of illicit liquor, where, there was

recovery of 159 litres of illicit IMFL/country made liquor.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner

submitted that alleged recovery of illicit liquor was made in front of



the house of one, Shivjee Sah, as petitioner stood near to place of recovery, his name was implicated falsely in present case. While concluding the argument, it is submitted that petitioner is a man of clean antecedent and moreover, investigation of this case is completed, for which charge-sheet has been submitted, as such, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Learned APP, opposes the prayer of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances as mentioned above, as petitioner is in custody since 21.07.2022, coupled with the fact that charge-sheet has been submitted, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Sursand P.S. Case No. 371 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court-II, Sitamarhi/concerned Court, subject to the conditions as mentioned under Section 437(3) of the Cr.P.C.
