Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- (i) For the grant of appropriate
compensation money quantified to be
Rs.5,00,000/- due to mal act of the
Respondent no.5 who has misbehaved
with the petitioner and took Rs.2500/-



against the fine money, when the petitioner was with the genuine railway ticket of sleeper coach S.11, birth no.48 for Ahmada Bad Railway Station to Patna Junction Railway Station dated 02.08.2019. And he has given a fine money receipt of Rs.1240/- only to the petitioner.

- (ii) For giving the direction for taking legal action against the Respondent No.5 and others Respondent who ~~are~~ ^{are} responsible for by initiating a departmental proceeding against the erring person by the competent authority concerned
- (iii) For the grant of other relief/reliefs to which the petitioner is found entitled to.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour of the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to take recourse to such other remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.



Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, before the appropriate forum/Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law, within a period of six months thereafter.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
