That this writ petition is being filed on behalf of the petitioner above named for commanding the respondents particular respondents Purnea Nagar Nigam to provide waitage to the petitioner who is an unemployed engineer pursuant to policy decision taken vide Memo No.2390(E) dated 10.04.2015 in light of order dated 21.09.2012 passed by this Hon'ble Court



vide CWJC No.17671/2012 by which the provision laid down for providing 15% reservation to the unemployed engineers in notified works under plan and non plan head of all departments and the petitioner comes under this said category but in the Tender invitation Notice No.09, year - 2019-20 dated 20.8.2019 issued by respondent no. 7 the same is deliberately over looked, hence an appropriate writ/ writs, direction/directions, order/orders may be issued directing the respondents to implement the said memo No.1090(E) dated 10..04.2015 issued by respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, for the same having rendered infructuous.
