That this writ application is being filed for quashing the office order vide no.BSDM/SDM-40/2021(Part-I)287 dated 25.03.2022 issued by and under the signature of the Respondent no.3 (Annexure-28) whereby and whereunder the Letter of Award (LOA), issued to the petitioner vide letter no.BSDM/SDM-40/2021(Part-1)-116 dated 09.02.2022 (Annexure-3) has been cancelled and Earnest Money Deposit of Rs.10 Lakh submitted to Bihar Skill Development Mission (In short "BSDM") has been forfeited. Further, the petitioner has been restrained from participating in future Tenders/RFP (Request for proposal) of BSDM for a further period of three years from the date of issuance of this letter i.e. 25.03.2022. It is humbly prayed to quash the office order dated 25.03.2022 issued by the Respondent no. 3 by issuance of an appropriate writ(s)/order(s)/ and/or direction(s) in the following facts and circumstances of the case.”
