Merely change of nomenclature of the Company that
does not wipe out relationship of employer and employee



among the petitioner and fifth respondent. Therefore, there is no infirmity in the order of the controlling and appellate authority. Hence, petitioners have not made out case.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
