2 12-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a

case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 45 litres of illicit country

made liquor from the houses of the petitioners. The

petitioners are alleged to have fled away from the place

of seizure.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the



petitioners that petitioners were not apprehended from the spot. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern with the recovery of the illicit liquor.

Considering the fact that petitioners are owner of the houses from where illicit liquor was recovered, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

The prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners stands rejected.
