High School, Rani Sakarpura, District- Khagaria has been terminated/dismissed without giving any proper chance of hearing the petitioner and without serving the termination/dismissal order to the petitioner and be further pleased to stay the operation of order of termination/dismissal of the petitioner as contained in Annexure-7 to the writ petition and be further pleased to grant any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is found entitled to.”

2. Considering it that this matter is covered by the Judgment dated 23.02.2022, passed in CWJC. NO. 5489 of 2020 (Suresh Ram Vs. The State of Bihar & ors.) and connected matters reported in 2022 (2) B.L.J., 381 and the Judgment dated 07.03.2022, passed in C.W.J.C. No. 34 of 2022 (Minakshi@ Sushre Minakshi & Anr. Vs. The State of Bihar & ors.), this petition is disposed of with the above terms.

3. If an appeal is preferred before the District Appellate Authority/ State Appellate Authority, the same shall be taken up



at the earliest and preferably decided within a period of six months.
