ORAL ORDER

10 05-09-2022 Heard the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 498(A) of the IPC.

Vide order dated 12.04.2022, matter was referred to the Mediation Centre by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

In that light, a Mediation report is kept at Flag 'Q', in which it is stated that the dispute between the parties has been resolved through the process of mediation, the terms of settlement agreed upon by them is enclosed with the report.

Considering the settlement arrived at by the parties, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of



their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No-535 (C)/ 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
