ORAL ORDER

2 13-12-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 414/
34 of the I.P.C. and Sections 30(a), 32(ii), 34(ii), 41(i) of the
Excise Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the allegation is
of recovery of 1921.08 litres of liquor from a truck and 513
litres of liquor from a pick-up van.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession. It is next submitted
that he came to be implicated at the instance of local spy which



the easiest way to implicate someone when admittedly, petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and it appears that petitioner has been implicated only to save the real culprits when petitioner has no concern with the alleged vehicle.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the bail application.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Mahua P. S. Case No.599 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The application stands allowed.
