ORAL ORDER

5 18-05-2022 A Show cause has been filed on behalf of Mr. Anshul Kumar, the then Sub-Divisional Officer, Danapur, Patna. In his show cause he has taken a stand that it was his first posting after completion of probation period and after going through the order of this Court he got a first impression in his mind that he had to consider the show cause of the petitioner and pass a fresh order at the earliest which he did within a reasonable time. He submits that the fact that this court had directed to restore the license and supply during the intervening period escaped his

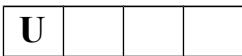


attention.

Although this court does not accept the ground taken by the then S.D.O. Danapur but finding that he is a young officer and it was his first posting as S.D.O. at Danapur, this Court is willing to take a lenient view of the matter giving him the benefit of doubt. This court would not proceed with the contempt application. It is dropped accordingly.
