Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

“ (a) To pay the dues amount of Rs. 74,97,000/-
(Rupees Seventy Four Lakhs Ninety Seven
Thousand) for the work executed (supply of
Electricity through 5 KVA silent Gen. Set to all 20
Bcks of the District of Saran, Chapra.

- (b) To pay penal interest @ 12% per annum from due date till the date of payment,
- (c) Any other relief/reliefs as petitioner is found entitled to.”

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and/or take recourse to such other alternative remedies, equally efficacious in law.

Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

Needless to add, the authorities/adjudicative body shall pass a reasoned order in accordance with law.

It is made clear that we have not expressed any opinion on merits. All issues are left open.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory Application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
