This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Audhaura P.S. Case No. 68 of 2016 for the offence punishable
under Sections 143, 341, 379, 504, 447 & 353 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced
before me an order dated 27.08.2020 passed in Criminal
Miscellaneous No. 5662 of 2020, by which similarly situated
co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail by a co-
ordinate Bench of this Court.

For the reason recorded in the order dated
27.08.2020 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 5662 of 2020,
