APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Bheldi P.S. Case No.131 of 2019 registered for offences under Sections 323, 379 and 498A of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

It appears that the opposite party no.2 is not interested in joining the matrimonial house and her lawyer is also not appearing in this case.

In view of the law laid down by the Apex Court in the case of *Arnesh Kumar V State Of Bihar* reported in (2014) 8 SCC 273, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XII, Saran at Chapra in connection with Bheldi P.S. Case No.131 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
