Circle Officer, Paharpur, District-East Champaran at Motihari,



whereby and whereunder in pursuance to the order passed in Encroachment Case No. 23 of 2016-17, police force has been requisitioned for removal of the encroachment in question, however, the encroachment could not be removed on account of non-availability of the police force.
