Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following reliefs:-

- (i) For issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the Respondents to promptly register First Information Report against persons involved in illegal mining of sand from the sand ghats in the District of Rohtas, Sasaram and to take appropriate actions against them.
- (ii) To issue further appropriate writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the Respondents to establish necessary check posts at appropriate places on all the sand ghats in order to check illegal mining and to ensure that transportation of sand is being done of valid and legal transit challans.
- (iii) To issue further appropriate writ, order or direction to Respondents to fix the responsibility over the responsible officers of the local police station within the jurisdiction of which illegal mining is happening.
- (iv) To adjudicate and hold that the respondents cannot allow valuable resource like sand to be squandered at the hands of illegal minors.
- (v) To award any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner is found entitled in the facts and the circumstances of the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as withdrawn.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
