The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the opposite parties for deliberately and wilfully not complying with the judgment dated 13.03.2018 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWJC No. 1443 of 2016, titled as Madan Mohan Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that in compliance of the directions issued by this Court in CWJC No.



1443 of 2016, titled as Madan Mohan Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors., a sum of Rs. 40-42 lakhs (approximately) stands determined to be due and payable to the petitioner, which shall positively be remitted into the petitioner's bank account on or before 30th of November, 2022.

Statement accepted and taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply particulars of the bank account of the petitioner to the learned counsel for the respondents within next five working days.
