ORAL ORDER

2 13-09-2022 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“(I) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus, commanding and directing the respondent authorities to make payment the following retiral dues:

(i) Amount of Group Insurance 12.5% compound interest till the date of payment like other employees.



(ii) Amount of D.D.A. @ 9% compound interest till the date of payment like other employees in view of judgment reported in 2006 Vol-IV PLJR page 369.

(iii) Any other admissible dues.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Vice-Chancellor, Lalit Narayan Mithila University, Kameshwar Nagar, Darbhanga for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.

Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
