2      19-09-2022                      Though, the present writ petition has been filed for payment of gratuity amount of the father of the petitioner, however, it is the contention of the learned counsel appearing for the respondent company that since the petitioner is 4 brothers and sisters, it is advisable that a succession certificate is produced by the petitioner for payment of the aforesaid amount for which the respondent company has issued a letter dated 16.04.2019 with regard to production of a succession certificate for the purposes of payment of gratuity amount.

In such view of the matter, learned counsel for the



petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Competent Court for grant of succession certificate and thereafter to approach the respondent company for payment of the aforesaid amount. Liberty so sought is granted.

The present writ petition stands disposed off.
