Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That the present writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioner before this Hon'ble Court against the finalisation of E-tender, dated 23.07.2019 in favour of private respondent no. 7 as per the order issued by the

Divisional Railway Manager (Respondent No. 3) as contained in प.सं-सी/536/पार्किंग स्टैंड/खगड़िया/सोन/2019 dated 20-11-2019 whereby ignoring the terms and conditions as published under E-tender notice 0-536-parking-khagaria/SEE-19 dated 26.06.2019 and by adopting the pick and choose method the impugned tender in favour of respondent no. 7 be declared illegal, improper and unjustified in the backdrop of the arbitrary event of favouritism. The petitioner further prays to direct the respondents not to proceed with execution of agreement and issuance of work order with reference to the e-tender as noted above and further consideration of tender documents in terms of the condition as notified under notice inviting the tender in fair and transparent manner and any other relief as this Hon'ble Court may found fit and proper to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as for which the petitioner may be found entitle thereto.

withdraw this petition.
